

# Traditional Foundation/Paper Piecing Class Description & Supply List

## CLASS DESCRIPTION

This class is an introduction to Traditional Foundation/Paper Piecing. Each student will learn the basics by constructing a Log Cabin and a Pineapple Block on a preprinted paper foundation. An optional Attic Windows Block is offered to present the basics of Flip-Flop Paper Piecing (enables the construction of blocks “impossible” to paper piece).

Advanced students are also welcome. They can bring their own foundation to whatever block they’d like to construct. They may well benefit from the Hot Tips presented and can receive one-on-one assistance to get started on their individual project.

## STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

- Pins (Thin, silk weight preferred, but not required).
- Scissors for cutting fabric and snipping thread.
- Scissors for cutting paper.
- Assortment of fabrics (darks and lights or two or more contrasting colors like red, green, and yellow), starched and pressed.
- Iron and ironing surface.
- Seam ripper.
- Rotary cutter and cutting ruler if you prefer to cut with a rotary cutter.
- Sewing machine with an open-toed (embroidery) foot or any foot that allows you to see and sew on a printed line. Sharply pointed and slightly large needle (an 80 or 90 Sharp [Jeans], Titanium, or Microtex). Single hole (straight stitch) throat plate is best if you have one.
- Thread and filled bobbin for your sewing machine.
- Extension cord for your sewing machine and iron
